- Glow Run

 - Next year, need better communication between the committee and the board. The committee needs to keep the board informed of their volunteers, and what is needed the day of from the board members.
 - o Committee needs to be present at the Executive Board meeting the month before.
 - Some suggestions for next year:
 - Paint lines week or 2 before on the blacktop so kids can practice.
 - Copy score sheets for parents and for spirit stick distribution.
 - Need volunteers for scoring, and have a scoring meeting the week before to train the volunteers, Don't rely on the police to score.
 - Need 3-4 adults helping kinder get their bikes.
 - Need 6 volunteers for traffic.
 - Need a sign up for kids to volunteer who aren't participating.

- Communication to parents before the event that they will be needed to park, and walk their child's bike to the assigned spot.
- Make a clear path for bikes when finished.
- Make sure ants are removed and the grass has been mowed.
- Have SUG available at first watch dog meeting to have dads available for volunteering.
- Water and ice chests already out and tents for scorers.
- Communication on SUG on what exactly is needed and expected.
- Schedule of events needs to be out early for both parents and teachers.
- Make SUG clear on what grade level to sign up to volunteer. So parents can volunteer and then watch their child participate.
- Someone on committee needs to be in charge of clean up at 3:15pm.
- Teacher name signs to designate bike section.
- Kick off meeting next to work out logistics.
- Have police officers come during PE to demonstrate what is expected and talk about bike safety.
