General Overview of PTO purpose and goals

- Treasurer's report was printed and passed out at sign-in. Summer Calong made a motion to approve the budget and Jamie White seconded. Budget was approved.
- Question was brought up by a parent where the \$30,000 fundraising budget came in. Jamie White and Summer Calong explained it was a prediction based on number of students this year to last year. Jamie explained how PTO funds the games and food,etc for the Fall Festival and Cowboy Breakfast as examples. Family night events also are PTO run.
 - Family Night Committee Introduction
 - September 19: Science Night- Fun family evening with Food Trucks and Kona Ice.
 - October 30: Story Book "Hall" oween. Students dress up as their favorite story book character and have a parade with a trunk or treat.
 - PTO spends on average \$3,000 on family nights to give back to the school.
 - Summer Calong also explained the checks written at the beginning of the year are reimbursing teachers for the extra money they spend during the summer getting their classrooms ready, supplies, and tools for their students.
